You must have an Emby Connect Account first

1. Locate your Emby Server , User and Password by clicking on your server


1. **Claim server**



How to Remove Invited Users



Limit Internet Streaming / Transcoding

We have found that setting this to 50 - will allow direct play to work easier and not require transcoding.

1. Select the User in your Emby Server - under Users

1.

2. Scroll down to Internet streaming bitrate limit (Mbps)

1. Internet streaming bitrate limit (Mbps)

An optional per-stream bitrate limit for all out of network devices. This is useful to prevent devices from requesting a higher bitrate than your Internet connection can handle. This may result in increased CPU load on your server in order to transcode videos on the fly to a lower bitrate.

This will override the default global value set in advanced server settings.

3. Set this to 50 and then scroll down to save
